Dan Croteau opened the floor to anyone who wanted to run for President or Treasurer. No one wanted to run for either position so by default, Dan Croteau retains the position of President and Zuri Chambers retains the position of Treasurer.

The team Brilliant Budz will now be known as Berlin City and their home court will be Fagin's Pub.

The team Round of 9 will now be known as Wizards.

A new team, Bookworms, has joined the American Division. Their captain is Charlene Gallagher and they will be playing out of the banquet side of the VFW.

The team Northern Pounders will now be playing out of the Banquet side of the VFW.

By a vote of 8-0-0 it was decided to stick to 7 teams in each division.

Kenny Nett was asked for an update on the plaques for the trophies. He said they were done but he was not happy with how they turned out. Dan asked that they be put on the trophies and we would look into getting the rest done by someone else.

An idea was brought up by Tina Viens of Jericho Outdoors. Due to some captains having to travel 45+ minutes for the monthly meetings, could we do some kind of a video meeting for the captain's meetings so those captains do not have to drive in potentially inclement weather to attend the meetings. A vote was held to determine if this was something the captains wanted. This was

passed by unanimous consent. We will look into setting up a zoom style meeting with both in person and remote participants.
