- A match in Week 1 between the Bookworms and Sharp Shooters was played at the Legion. The match ran late and they asked Suzy if they could make up their final set on Friday at 10pm there at the Legion. Suzy agreed to allow them to play. On Friday September 13<sup>th</sup>, Suzy waited at the Legion and had a trainee stay as well until 11pm before deciding that they weren't going to show up. The match was instead played at the Bowling Center and no one bothered to let the Legion know about the change in venue.
  - Per Dan: If a match needs to be finished on a later date, it should be finished at the same venue it was started at. If this does not work out and arrangements are made to play in another location and those arrangements need to be changed, someone needs to contact the venue ahead of time so they are not waiting for us. We need to treat the bartenders and venues with respect.
- DartConnect's Express Player Lineup. This will give the captain and/or Co-captain the ability
  to fill out their roster on DartConnect in advance digitally. It does NOT have to be used but
  will make things easier for shooting order and preventing errors in selecting players for a set.
  Captains can fill out the roster at any time though writing it down to bring to the match in
  order to fill out the Match Report Sheet is strongly recommended.
- A person was keeping score for the Misfits Vs Bookworms on 9-16-24 (Week 2) and they had earbuds in while keeping score. The scorekeeper was unable to hear the player when they were asked to enter the score so they could see what they had left. The Scorekeeper was asked to remove the Ear Buds while scoring.
  - Dan is okay with people using ear buds or headphones but they must be able to hear the players at all times. People are asked to remove one side so they can hear.
     Also, scorekeeper etiquette should be followed. Keep still as much as possible and do not distract the throwers.
- Matches are to start at 7:45 PM. This means players should be ready to throw at 7:45pm.
   Many matches are starting later than 8:00pm due to players not arriving until well after 7:45pm.
   13 of 24 matches have started after 8:00pm this season.
  - Dan did state that the past 2 weeks were much better. All matches had finished by 11:45pm and thanked everyone. He did say that we would like to see about finishing by 11:30pm moving forward which we feel can be achieved by having players ready and matches starting earlier.

- In the notables section, please write legibly. Some of the sheets we are receiving are very difficult to read. Using only numbers also helps a lot. 140, 100, 138 is easier to read that 1T4, T, 3T8. (See examples at the end of the minutes)
- Please try to make sure all tons are being written down. In the week 4 match between Sharp Shooter s and Berlin Spring, there were two tons for Berlin Spring that did not get written down.
- The Bowling Center has changed its Wi-Fi and password. Please see the bartender or the owner Dan to get the new information and connect to the new Wi-Fi.
- The DartConnect Bill of \$280 is due September 23<sup>rd</sup> and needs to be paid within 10 days of September 23<sup>rd</sup>. Dan will get together with Zuri Wednesday October 2<sup>nd</sup>) to get the money to pay this.
  - o Bill was paid on October 2<sup>nd</sup> 2024 and copy of paid invoice sent to Zuri and Dan.
- There was an issue where a player left a cell phone at the VFW. It was taken home by someone and later returned. It was asked if players can turn any found items into the bartenders at the respective venues, it would be greatly appreciated and make things easier on people if they lose or misplace items.


