New Items

- **Match Report Sheets**
 - o **ALL singles matches must have the number of legs written down.**
 - o **Once the Match Report Sheet is signed and turned in, NO CHANGES will be allowed.**
 - **The person signing the sheet NEEDS TO verify all notables, scores, and number of legs are written down and are correct.**
 - o **Only 6 bulls in one round is considered a notable and is also a payout.**
- **Mike Smith expressed concern over how the team Just the Tip's punishment was handled. Dan clarified the reasons why the punishment we chose were handed down.**
- **Mike Smith also expressed concern about the unbalanced number of teams in the National versus American divisions. This was also clarified and it was explained that the captains voted to have 8 in the National and 4 in the American.**
- **Zuri Chambers clarified an issue. In the event a player is kicked out of a venue, the match is to continue as though that player is not in attendance. Any team games that player was in are now played shorthanded unless a sub was written in before the start of the match. Any singles matches are an automatic forfeit. The match cannot be rescheduled so the ejected player may participate. In the event that the bartender calls the night and the match is not complete, it **MUST** be completed the following day.**

- **Mike Smith mentioned revisiting start times due to difficulty with doubles in the American Division. It was stated that captains can speak with each other and decide to start earlier if it is okay with both teams. In the event that teams agree to an earlier start time, they MUST get in contact with the venue ahead of time to make sure it is okay with the venue to start earlier.**
- **Amy Lacasse asked for clarification on a player coming in after the start of the match. Matches are to start NO LATER than 8:00pm. If a player comes in after the start of the match, they are able to join in any games they were scheduled to play in. This includes games already in progress.**
- **Zuri Chambers brought up players taking smoke breaks AGAIN. This seems to be affecting the American Division mostly. PLEASE look ahead on the match report sheet and be courteous. If you are playing in the next game, make sure you have enough time to take your break and get back to the match BEFORE your next game starts.**
- **Amy Lacasse asked if singles matches can be played out of order. We should try our best to play the matches in order but we are able to move around if needed.**
- **Amy Lacasse brought up an issue with a player coming into contact with her leg while she was throwing darts. DO NOT come into contact with another player, especially when they are engaged at the line. This can be seen as interfering with a player and distracting them which can result in disciplinary action from the league.**
- **Amy Lacasse and Dan Croteau spoke about scorekeepers. Scorekeepers are to remain standing still and engaged with the board. Scorekeepers are NOT to have conversations with the players at the scoreboard unless speaking about their current score before the darts are pulled. Please see Scorekeeper etiquette attached to this document.**
- **Becky Dube asked for clarification on starting matches when people are missing. Matches are to start no later than 8:00pm. If a team has less than 4 players in attendance at 8:00pm, we can choose to wait for a few minutes (5-10) but if the team does not have enough players, this is a forfeit. If the shorthanded team has 4 or more players, the match is to start at 8:00pm and late players can join in when they arrive. If the team's captain and Co-captain are not present to fill out the Match Report Sheet, any player in attendance can fill out the sheet.**

- Dan Croteau wants to remind everyone that we are here to have fun above all else. Our Bylaws are merely guidelines and there are some situations where we can bend them. Relax, have fun, and shoot good darts.
- Reminder: Bartenders can shut down matches at 11:30pm. If this is done, matches need to be finished the next day or they stand where the match was left off.

RULES FOR SCOREKEEPERS

1. Always face forward, at an angle to best view the board when possible.
2. Never step or lean into the shooting lane before all darts are thrown, unless asked to check where a dart landed.
3. Always project a neutral disposition when scoring.
4. Never coach or suggest what to throw at.
5. Refrain from making noises, using cell phones, or speaking during a throw unless asked a question by the shooter.
6. Refrain from moving or fidgeting while a shooter is on the line.
7. Refrain from moving your head or looking away from the board during a player's throw and never look at the shooter during their turn.
8. No eating, drinking, or vaping while keeping score.

9. If asked to be replaced, do not argue or complain, calmly walk out of the shooting lanes without distracting other games.
