- Lucien LeVeille brought in a new copy of the bylaws for captains to review. The bylaws will be updated on the league's website soon. Dan Croteau went over the two changes. We added that the league was established in 1982 and updated the section describing what type of boards we should be using to keep things up to date with current technology. Since these changes were voted on in previous meetings, captains in attendance were asked to read over the changes and speak with Dan or Lucien if there were any issues.
 - A lot of notables have not been getting written down on the Match Report Sheet, especially Rounds of 7 or 8. People have been asked why and the most common reply is, "Why write it down? Lucien will catch it in DartConnect and correct it." While yes, Lucien and Dan go through DartConnect and do their stats separately and then Lucien sends his to Dan for approval before posting it, DartConnect can be wrong. In week 8 there was a match where people played under the wrong name so a person was marked down for a notable in DartConnect that they did not actually hit. With the High Marks Club now being something we pay out prize money for, it is important that we have accurate stats.
 - In week 8 a match was played between the Flight Risks and Northland Interiors where the shooters played as the wrong person. When the tablet said "Joe" Jon shot and when it said "Jon" Joe was shooting. This is not to call out the players; this is hopefully to allow others to understand better. The mistake was caught towards the end of the 301. For leg 2, the teams decided to keep playing the match as the wrong people. If this happens again to any teams, please do exactly what they did and continue to play as the wrong players. This will ensure that there will be a game 3 if needed. If you try to "fix it" and play as the correct person, there's a chance that the match could be incorrectly "won" and closed and not allow you to play the third leg of the set. In the event of a mistake like this, Flight Risks and Northland Interiors handled this perfectly. They kept playing as the wrong person and notified Lucien of the mistake. Lucien asked the captain to send him a text of who the people were and who actually won the set. It is quite a process to fix this type of mistake so if there aren't any notables, Lucien may just award the points and leave the scores alone but in this case there were notables so Lucien had to take a picture of each leg and then reopen the match and re-enter every single round like the scorekeeper did to make sure that the players got the proper stats.
 - Match Report Sheets – When writing in a player as a sub, it is important to cross out whichever player did not play. Per the bylaws Section 7 B iii - If a listed player does not play for any

reason, a single line is to be drawn through their name indicating they did not play. The player's name must still be legible.

- At the end of the night, Home teams at the Pub are responsible for putting the tables and chairs back. Natalee cannot physically do this herself nor should she have to.
- At the VFW, We need to make sure that we are picking up and putting away tablet holders and lights. This is the responsibility of the home team. Again, staff should not be picking up after us.
- Dan mentioned that during week 9's matches (11-3-2025) he witnessed the entire Sharp Shooters team outside for their "Quick break" after 501. This break took 16 minutes while the other team was inside ready to play. Dan will speak to the team captain about this. Please keep the break times courteous to other players and teams. Tina Viens (Jericho Outdoors) also mentioned that the same night, the entire team of Just the Tip was outside together as well and she eventually went and got the ones that were due up.
- Lucien also mentioned that he has twice seen the handicapped board being set up after matches have already started. Once in week 7 at the VFW when the Sharp Shooters played against the Wizards and again during week 9 when the Sharp Shooters played against the Misfits at the American Legion. During Week 9 there were 3 matches being played out of the Legion so things were extremely crowded. This is disrespectful and distracting to the other teams. Dan will also speak to Amy, the captain of the Sharp Shooters about trying to get there earlier, prior to the match start so there is enough time to set up the board before the match begins.
