- The Bylaws Section 4A states “All League competition including tournaments and play-offs shall be on Standard English bristle board with the 20-point clock face, of the hand wired variety. This means having wires on the outside of the board separating the single, double, and triple sections.” Currently we are using Blade/razor style wiring where the wires are not on the outside of the board. It is recommended that we update the bylaws.
 - A vote was held to change the bylaws to bring the bylaws current. 6 people voted to change the bylaws and 0 people voted against it.
 - A copy of bylaws was not provided at this meeting due to this potential change. Revised bylaws will be provided at the November meeting.
- It was brought up to reiterate that the Scorekeeper should not be telling people what to throw at while they are keeping score. The scorekeeper should remain silent and motionless (as much as possible) while players are throwing. The only time a scorekeeper should speak is when they are asked a question. The scorekeeper should not tell a player what to throw at and merely say “40 remains” instead of “Hit a Double 20”.
- We all know that keeping score is not the best part about darts. We went over to DartConnect to help make it easier for people to keep score. DartConnect has a built in calculator for those who aren't as comfortable with math as others. It's never fun to keep score for your own match so please, if you see a leg needs a scorekeeper, jump in and help out!
- There was an issue in Week 5 October 6th 2025 for the National Division where captains were putting their lineup into the tablets at the beginning of the night and the two tablets did not communicate the lineups with each other. Lucien will reach out to DartConnect to figure out what's going on. This came up for all three matches.
 - Lucien will keep us informed of any information from DartConnect on this matter. As of 6:45pm on October 7th 2025 there was no word from DartConnect about this issue.
- Charlene Gallagher (Bookworms Captain) asked for clarification on a rule. When a dart is thrown and the player has remaining darts in hand, a scorekeeper can type in the player's temporary score without hitting enter to show the player what they have remaining. If that dart

falls out before the end of the player's turn, does the score count since it was "entered into" the tablet?

- Dan clarified that the dart does not count because it fell out of the board before the end of the player's turn. We should use the undo button to remove that score and enter in the correct score. A player's turn technically ends after their darts are thrown and they touch the darts in the board.
- Dan also went on to explain that if all three darts are thrown, the thrower walks up and both the player and scorekeeper acknowledge the throw ie. Both say "You hit 5 18's" then a dart falls out, the throw still counts as it was agreed upon by both the thrower and the scorekeeper.
- Dan also mentioned the rule about a thrown dart that falls but the tip still touches a part of the board. If this happens and the tip is barely touching the face of the board, that dart counts. The score of that dart is where the tip is touching the board's face.
